September 8, 2005 – Multi-platinum artist Keith Urban has captivated audiences around the world with his astonishing live performances, and will now conquer the big screen with the premiere of his first ever concert DVD, *Livin’ Right Now*, on Monday, September 26th, at 85 movie theatres nationwide beginning at 7 p.m. local time (6:00 p.m. in Alaska).

The two-hour Big Screen ConcertsSM event will feature an exclusive introduction from Keith Urban and the DVD’s amazing concert footage, filmed during his two-day engagement at the historic Wiltern Theatre in Los Angeles. The show contains a wide-ranging collection of Urban’s music including all six of his #1 singles, such as “Days Go By” and “Making Memories Of Us,” from his double platinum album *Be Here*, as well as his record breaking #1 “Somebody Like You,” “You’ll Think Of Me,” “Who Wouldn’t Wanna Be Me,” plus the first and only commercial audio release of his rendition of Billy Thorpe’s “Most People I Know (Think That I’m Crazy)” featured in the GAP fall campaign “Favorites.” The event will also feature some of the DVD’s behind the scenes footage, including Urban at sound check and personal perspectives from Urban about his music.

“I’m very excited about this chance to connect with my fans in a whole new way,” remarked Keith Urban. “Also, It is my hope that, by donating a portion of the proceeds from this special event to the American Red Cross’ hurricane relief efforts, we’re helping support our fellow citizens in these hard-hit communities and letting them know that we stand together through this terrible crisis.”

Keith Urban: *Livin' Right Now* will be presented by National CineMedia in High Definition and Cinema Surround Audio at participating Regal, United Artists, Edwards and Georgia Theatre Company movie theatres across the country. Considered one of the music industry's most electrifying live performers, as well as one of its most gifted songwriters, Capitol Records Nashville artist Keith Urban has sold over 6 million albums world-wide, is the 2004 Country Music Association's Male Vocalist of the Year and 2005 Academy of Country Music Top Male Vocalist with a remarkable track record of six #1 songs and nine Top 5 hits and has racked up an international collection of gold, platinum and double-platinum sales achievements - all accomplished with three solo albums. Earlier this week, he received nominations for four 2005 Country Music Awards, including Entertainer of the Year; Male Vocalist of the Year; Album of the Year for the multi-platinum *Be Here*; and Music Video of the Year.
